INSIGHTS

After the festive break, companies in the UK games industry are hiring for the new year with 2,554 open positions, approaching November 2021's peak of 2,557.

A large portion of the new job listings are represented in Mobile studios (+34), with a notable increase in Indie roles (+13) as

well. We have also seen that many new jobs have appeared in the Midlands (+42), Scotland (+32) and Yorkshire (+24), contributing to this month's small shift away from London / South East (+ 1.7% of jobs are outside London / South East)

This month, there has been a notable increase in Junior roles

(+20) as this year's internships and graduate schemes start to appear.

The studios with the most new open positions include: Pole to Win (+40), Kwalee (+20), EA (+11) and Jagex (+11). The studios with the most filled / closed positions include; PlayStation (-21), Unity (-18) and Supermassive Games (-14).
