Welcome to the April 2023 jobs report. There has been another decrease of almost 100 open roles in the UK Games industry this month, with a major studio removing almost all of their roles.

The number of indie roles has once again increased as the rest of the industry declines, and a new AAA studio with a notable founder has officially opened its doors.

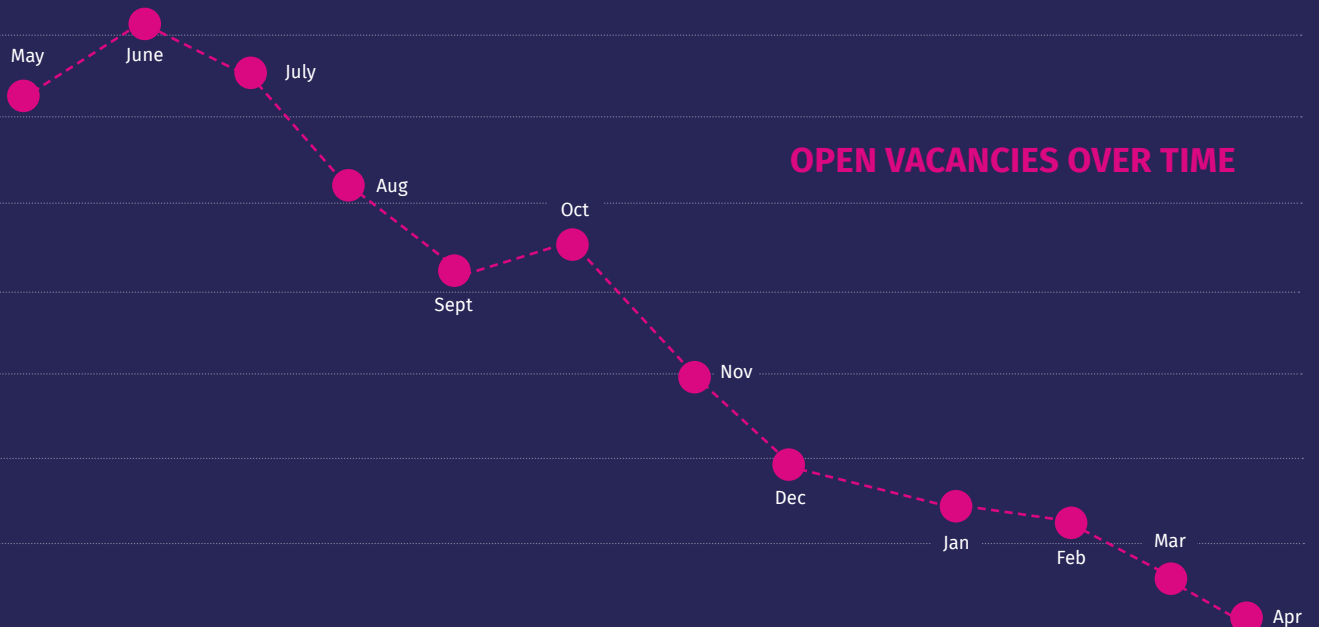
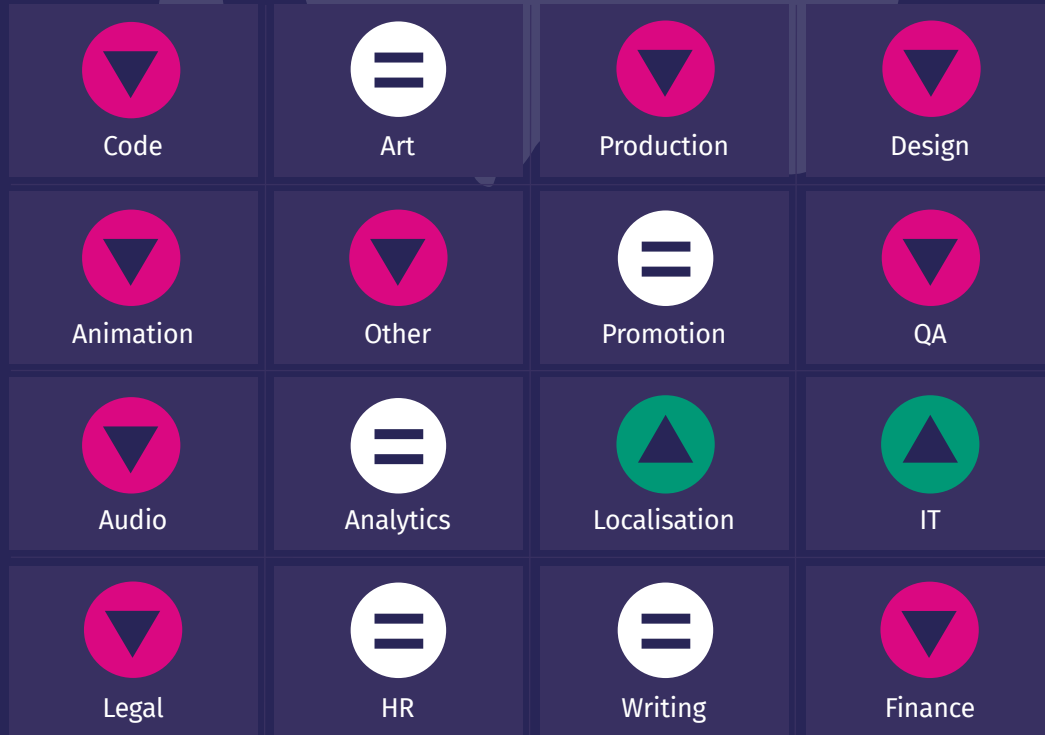

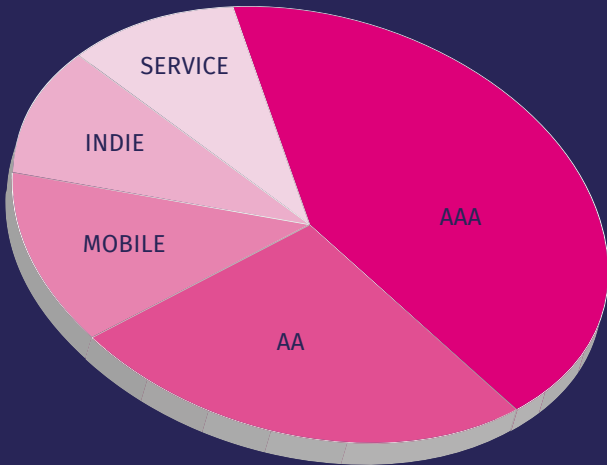
All but one of the largest hubs had a significant reduction in roles, with one city in particular having under half of the number of available jobs as last month.



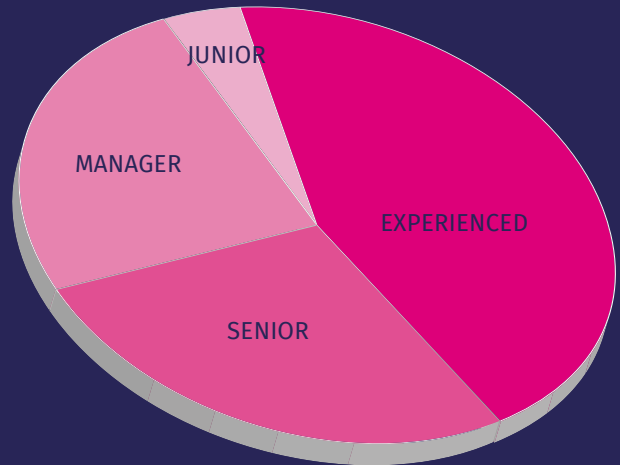
Available jobs across all disciplines decreased, primarily roles in Production.



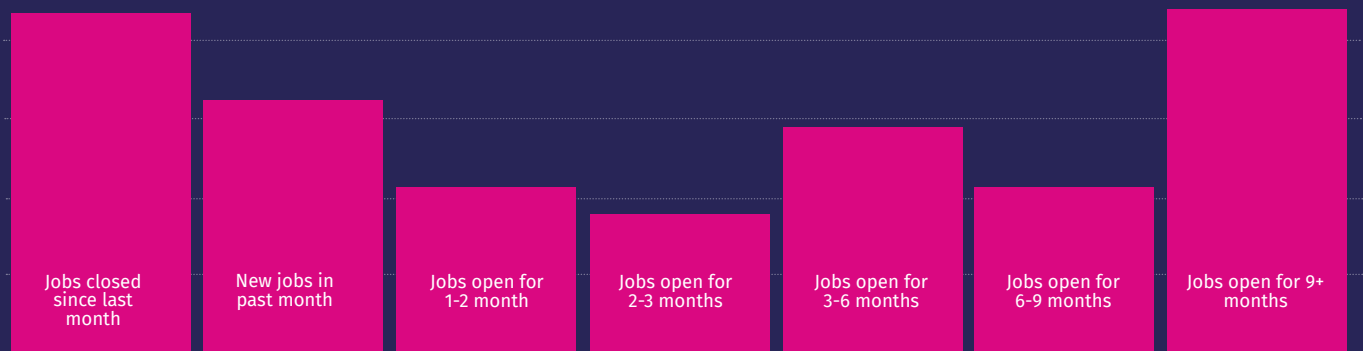
JOBS BY STUDIO CATEGORY

AGE OF JOBS



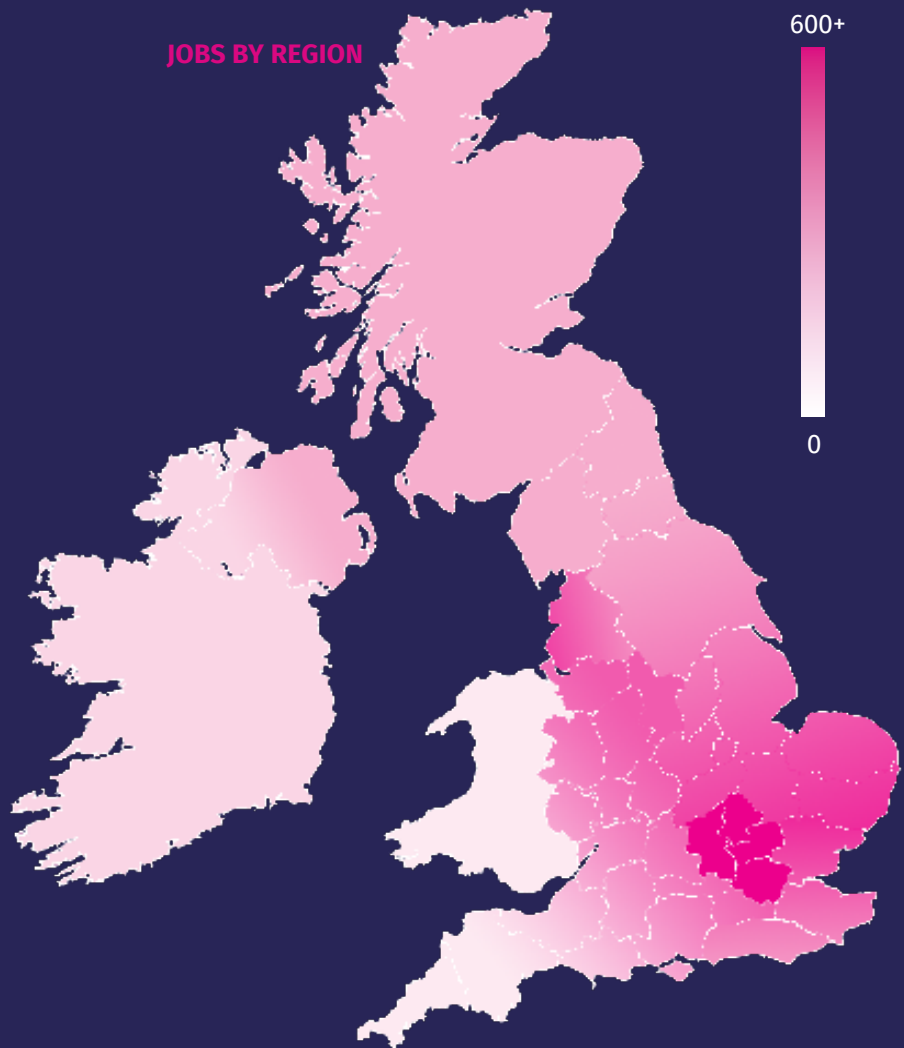
INSIGHTS

With the number of available games jobs in the UK hitting a new low, the UK Games Industry continues the trend of the last few months. Following the layoffs at Amazon's gaming divisions, a prominent indie publisher has also had a round of redundancies in the past month.

Indie studios continue to increase their available job roles while Mobile developers continue to cut back new hires. One region of the UK managed to increase their number of available jobs against the trend of decline.
